



## **RxA's Advancing the Profession Scholarship**

The Alberta Pharmacists' Association (RxA) in partnership with TD Insurance and the Canadian Pharmacists Benefits Association (CPBA) will award up to two scholarships to a candidate(s) who demonstrate the leadership skills and professional insight to advance pharmacy practice in Alberta.

Award #1 – will consist of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or any such dollar amount provided by TD Insurance.

Award #2 – will consist of malpractice insurance for one year and the cash differential to a total value of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or any such equivalent amount as provided by CPBA.

Each award will also include complimentary registration to one of RxA's two professional development conferences.

### Eligibility

Be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident of Canada.

- Be a 2020 Graduate of the University of Alberta Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- Be a current RxA Pharmacist Member as of September 1, 2020.
- Nominations for this award must be received by the Selection Committee by the published deadline. The nominee cannot be currently serving on the Selection Committee.
- The recipient cannot be the same for Award #1 and Award #2.

### Application Guidelines

#### 1. Candidate Information

- Complete the Candidate Information section (see below). Applications must be typed.
- Sign and date your completed application.

#### 2. Essay

- In no more than 750 words, describe, "What is your role as a pharmacy student in advocating for the profession now and how will your role change once you are a practicing pharmacist?"
- Essays containing more than 750 words will not be forwarded to the selection committee.

#### 3. Curriculum Vitae (CV)

- Outline work experience and academic accomplishments related to pharmacy.



## Award Presented

- A framed certificate and cheque.
- The recipients will receive their awards at RxA's Annual General Meeting on November 5, 2020.
- The recipients will be promoted through RxA publications, website and social media; letters from RxA to their employers.
