




Which best describes your position?






Which best describes your practice area?


How many years have you been practicing?





What area of the province do you work in?




On average, how many hours do you work per week?







What proportion do you work in one pharmacy location to multiple locations?













If yes, does your pharmacy administer vaccines by pharmacists, nurses, or a combination?






Pharmacy practice and economics are shifting across the country; do you expect your wage to:





How many weeks of paid vacation do you receive?










Do you receive Shift Differential (e.g., increased wage for working nights, weekends and/or holidays)?








Do you receive compensation for working overtime?


